As your Post Service Officer, the following information on receiving benefits for service related conditions you may have received during your time on active duty may apply to you.

## The PACT Act and your VA benefits

The PACT Act is a new law that expands VA health care and benefits for Veterans exposed to burn pits, Agent Orange, and other toxic substances. It affects Vietnam era Veteran, Gulf War era and post-9/11 Veteran eligibility.

Also the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) <u>Whole Health Systems</u> approach invites Veterans everywhere to take charge of their health and well-being and to live life to the fullest. The VA commitment is to empower, equip, and treat Veterans based on their priorities with the support of <u>Whole Health Peer Facilitators</u> who serve as partners on the Veterans health team. This is an essential element of the VA's new Whole Health System. You can go on line to <u>va.gov/wholehealth</u> to learn about all of the programs available.



New Hartford American Legion House Rules for the Queen of Hearts



The hunt for the "Queen" continues, as of August 22nd the "Queen" now stands @ \$5251 with 23 cards left.

All Post 1376 members, (Legionnaires, Auxiliary &S.A.L.) and bona fide guests over 18 years of age may play the Queen of Hearts.

The search for the Queen of Hearts will consist of a drawing each Wednesday *a* 7:15 PM. One Ticket will be drawn each week; except the first and twenty-sixth week, when three tickets will be drawn, until the Queen of Hearts is found.

Tickets will consist of two part sequentially numbered raffle tickets. TICKETS WILL COST \$1.00 EACH. Each player shall write his/her name and phone number on the Posts part of the ticket, which shall be deposited into the raffle box. The purchasing player shall retain the other portion of the ticket as a receipt for verification purposes. The player holding the winning ticket stub shall be declared the winner of the drawing and shall be entitled to "search for the Queen of Hearts". Each winner shall select one of the facedown playing cards, which shall be turned over by the member in charge. If the playing card

turned over is the Queen of Hearts, the holder of the winning ticket shall be awarded 60% of the grand prize pool. If the card selected is NOT the Queen of Hearts, the card shall be defaced and returned to the game board face up. The player drawing a card other than the Queen of Hearts shall be awarded a cash prize according to the following schedule:

New Hartford Sons of the American Legion Bill Brucato, Manager About Our Service Officer Dennis Thorp



An interesting article was published in the Rome Sentinel Newspaper in June on our Service Officer Dennis Thorp. This is part of the article published;

Dennis Thorpe, a combat medic in the Army, has a journey that exemplifies resilience, dedication, and the profound impact of military service. Reflecting on his experiences, he opens up about his time in the service, the challenges he faced, and his ongoing commitment to supporting fellow veterans.

During his deployment, he served with Task Force South First Field Forces, assigned to an artillery unit. This unit was uniquely positioned, surrounded by elite infantry units like the Green Berets, the Army Rangers, and the 101st Airborne. They played a crucial part in the Vietnamese insurgents' resistance movement, a period marked by intense and unforgettable experiences.

His time in the military left a profound mark on him. "I learned to distance myself from a lot of people because of the fact that I've seen so many of them lost," he shares, revealing the deep emotional scars left by his service. The specter of PTSD continues to haunt him, a reminder of the sacrifices made by those in uniform.

He expresses strong feelings about the current state of veterans' rights and support services. "I think they stink, I really do. They are taking away a lot of benefits without people realizing it," he states, highlighting the need for greater awareness and advocacy for veterans' issues.

Today, he serves as a service officer for the American Legion in New Hartford. For the past 20 years, he has worked closely with veterans from Desert Storm and subsequent conflicts, offering support and guidance. His dedication to aiding new veterans is a testament to his enduring commitment to his comrades.

I would like to add a note of personal thanks to Dennis for all he has and continues to do for all of our Veterans.

# New Eligibility Requirements For The American Legion

The LEGION Act, signed into law July 30, 2019, expands eligibility in The American Legion to include veterans who served in U.S. military conflicts previously unrecognized by Congress as war eras.

If you have served at least one day of federal active duty in the United States Armed Forces since December 7, 1941, and have been honorably discharged or are still serving - you are eligible for membership in The American Legion!

\*Because eligibility dates remain open, all active duty members of the U.S. Armed Forces are eligible to join The American Legion at this time, until the date pay your dues anytime. Thank You. NOTE: Our of the end of hostilities as determined by the government of the United States.

\*\*U.S. Merchant Marine eligible only from December 7, 1941 to December 31, 1946 (WWII).

A copy of your DD-214 or Honorable Discharge **Certificate** confirming your eligibility is required when joining.
