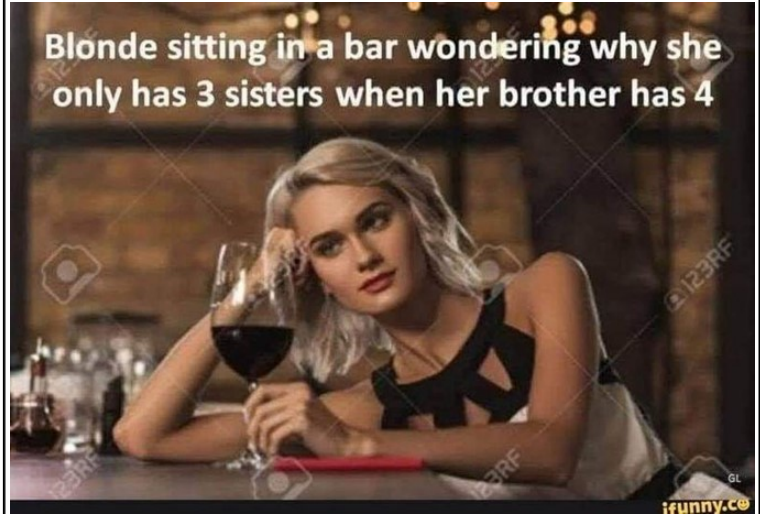

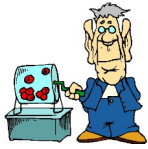

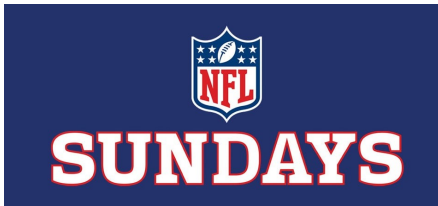

The hunt for the **“Queen”** continues, as of **December 19th** the **“Queen”** now stands @ **\$1492** with **48** cards left.

The drawing for the **“Queen”** is held every **Wednesday** at **7:00 PM**. You can purchase tickets any day at the **Bar** or at the **SAL** table **Wednesdays** in the **Lounge**.

All **Post 1376** members and **bona fide** guests over the age of **18** may play **The Queen of Hearts**.

One ticket will be drawn each week; except the first and twenty-sixth week, when three will be drawn, until the **Queen of Hearts** is found. Tickets will be a series of two part-sequentially numbered raffle tickets. **TICKETS WILL COST \$1.00 EACH**, and you may purchase as many tickets as you wish.

Each player shall write their name and phone number and card number you would like selected if you are not present at the drawing on the Posts part of the ticket, which shall be deposited into the raffle box. The purchasing player shall retain the other portion of the ticket as a receipt for verification purposes. The player holding the winning ticket stub shall be declared the winner of the drawing and shall be entitled to **“Search for the Queen of Hearts”**.

Each winner shall select one of the facedown playing cards, which shall be turned over by the member in charge. If the card turned over is the **Queen of Hearts**, the holder of the winning ticket selecting that card shall be awarded **60%** of the grand prize pool. 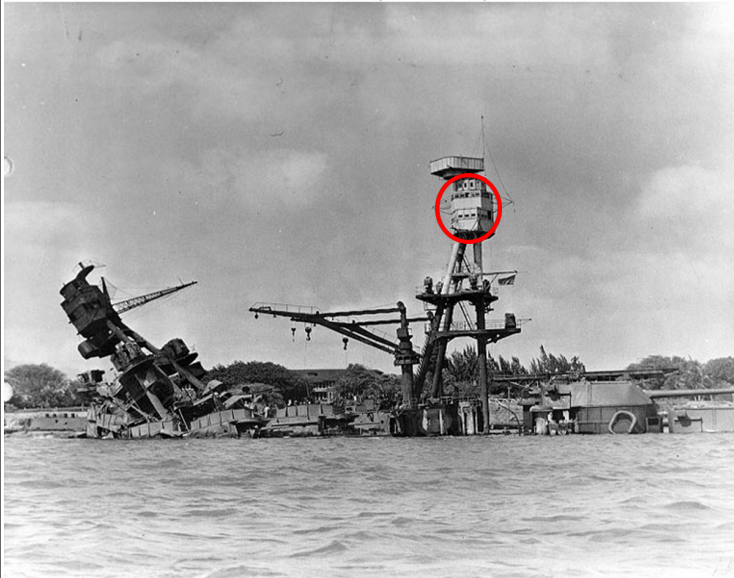
As a reminder we have a suggestion box available to all members. We ask that they sign and put in any suggestions that they may have that they feel would help improve and/or enhance our American Legion Post.

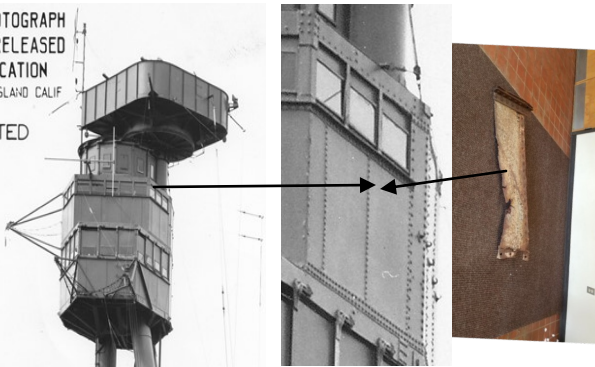
USS Arizona BB 39

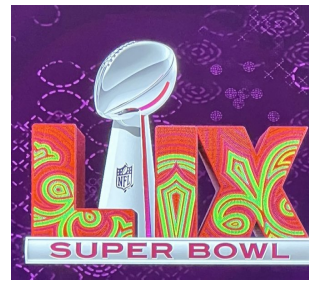
This year there was a piece of the **Super Structure** of the **USS Arizona BB 39** on display.

With the help of **Fred Griffiths**, he sent us a copy of the attached **paperwork** granting the **request** for a piece of the **USS Arizona** to be **permanently** displayed here.

The piece of the **USS Arizona Aft Super Structure** relic is what **New York Mills** has received. Unfortunately, the **Bator Post #21 Polish Legion American Veterans** was unable to **secure** a **safe** and **public** place to **display** the **relic** as was requested by the **US Naval Historical Center** before to it **folded** and became part of the **NYS Department of New York PLAV**.

Pictures above show the possible **location** of the **Aft Super Structure** from which the **relic** piece may have come from. The **picture** on the **bottom right** is the **relic** piece that was **received** here and was **displayed** at the **Pearl Harbor Ceremony** in **New York Mills** on **December 7th**.

New Eligibility Requirements For The American Legion

The **LEGION Act**, signed into law **July 30, 2019**, expands eligibility in **The American Legion** to include **veterans** who served in **U.S. military conflicts** previously unrecognized by **Congress** as war eras.

If you have served at least one day of federal active duty in the **United States Armed Forces** since **December 7, 1941**, and have been **honorably discharged** or are **still serving** - you are **eligible** for membership in **The American Legion!**

***Because eligibility dates remain open, all active duty members of the U.S. Armed Forces are eligible to join the American Legion at this time, until the date of the end of hostilities as determined by the government of the United States.**

****U.S. Merchant Marine eligible only from December 7, 1941 to December 31, 1946 (WWII).**

A copy of your **DD-214** or **Honorable Discharge Certificate** confirming your **eligibility** is required when joining.

Above is the **new membership application form** for the **American Legion**. If you know of someone who may be interested in joining, cut this form out for them.

Dues are currently **\$50.00**, checks can be made out to **New Hartford American Legion Post 1376** and they can mail it along with a copy of their **DD214** discharge papers to:
